4. President's report

We received \$1000 for the grant to build nest boxes for Eastern Rosellas in the parklands. Peter Wiltshire presented his Ranger's report. It has been a chaotic couple of months, particularly with the two floods. Highest flow rate previously recorded was 28 kmh, yet the most recent floods flowed at 34 kmh. 70mm of rain in the upper catchment = 3 m of water in the parklands. The creek is now biologically dead, with no fish or plant life at all, although it will gradually recover.

The enterprise centre was robbed, with DCMC losing valuable tools and equipment. Then 109 kmh winds destroyed several trees.

October 11 bonfire night to go ahead as planned.
