The Darebin Parklands Association (DPA) is a voluntary group that has cared for the park since 1973. The Junior Ranger Club is for our younger members and is all about having fun in the park and learning to care for the environment.



Junior ranger activities

Throughout the year the DPA holds special “just for kids” events including spotlighting and bonfire night. These events are free for Junior Rangers. Junior Rangers are also encouraged to come along to park care days and learn about planting trees and keeping the park environment clean and healthy. Other fun activities include catch a carp day, picnic races and water pollution action days.



Who can join?

Junior Ranger membership is designed for children under 15 years old. It is provided automatically as part of a DPA Family Membership.

How do I join?

DPA membership is based on a calendar year, renewable on January 1st. (Membership fees paid after November 1st cover the following calendar year).

DPA volunteers run events with assistance from the park rangers but for safety reasons, parents must supervise their children at all Junior Ranger activities.
