Did you know?

Up to 250,000 people use the beautiful Darebin Parklands each year.

Local groups and wildlife include:



Bush kinder, elderly residents, recreational cyclists and picnickers



Rakalis, Echidnas, Long Neck Turtles, Wood (Maned) Duck, Nankeen Night Heron and Tiger Snake

Some of these groups, particularly the very old, very young and native wildlife can be frightened of dogs off lead.

Respect other park users by keeping your dog on lead when outside the off lead area.

Darebin Creek Management Committee encourages people to get out in the park with their dogs by:



Providing an extensive fenced "dog off lead" area of 5 hectares to exercise your dog



Maintaining the designated 5 hectares of "dog off lead" area for 2,500 dog walkers per week



Providing plastic bags for dog walkers to pick up and dispose of their dog's waste

Help us make Darebin Parklands a safe and enjoyable environment for all park users. Respect other park users – be a responsible pet owner.



Please keep your dogs on lead in all areas outside the designated "dog off lead" area.
